Diana Clokey**

Diana Clokey is a native New Mexican, employed by the School of Medicine at UNM, Division of Maternal-Fetal Medicine. She began as a research nutritionist, which stimulated an interest in pharmacology. She was a pharmacist with the Milagro Program (for pregnant drug-addicted women) from 1997-1999.

Ms. Clokey is currently the program coordinator for Diabetes in Pregnancy at UNM. As part of her outreach activities, she lectures throughout the state. She also instructs medical students, residents, fellows, nursing students, dietitians and pharmacy students on the management of diabetes in pregnancy.
